## Virginia Space Flight Academy RULES and GOOD BEHAVIOR CONTRACT

The Virginia Space Flight Academy is a residential learning center which provides hands-on learning opportunities in rocketry, robotics, and related subjects. The VSFA is committed to a philosophy of mutual tolerance and respect. All students admitted to VSFA programs should fully understand, and be willing to help maintain, the Academy's safe and welcoming learning environment.

The rules and regulations, which follow, have been adopted in order to assure the safety and privacy of all participants in the various programs offered by The Virginia Space Flight Academy.

- 1. Students will be respectful to other campers and the staff. There will be no fighting, bullying, swearing, name calling, or any other inappropriate or unacceptable behavior. Report any of these offenses to an adult
- 2. Students are responsible for the conditions of their room and will be charged for damages to VSFA property and the property of our partners.
- 3. Food is not allowed in dorm rooms. It may be eaten in the dorm common room.
- 4. VSFA is a drug, alcohol, and tobacco free campus. Therefore, these substances are prohibited. Students are subject to dismissal without refund for violation of this rule. Prescribed medications must be kept in their original bottles with the dosage clearly indicated. With the exception of emergency medication (e.g. bee sting kits, inhalers) all medications will be held by the counselor.
- 5. Quiet hours extend from 10:00pm to 6:00am. This is for the benefit of everyone living in close community with others. Please keep noise to a minimum during this time.
- 6. No inter-visitation between male and female dormitories areas is permitted.
- 7. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times. Closed-toe shoes are required during the day outside of the of the dormitory complex.
- 8. No overnight visitors are allowed. Students and visitors are not allowed to bring pets to the grounds.

The following is the procedure we use when a camper is involved in unacceptable behavior:

- First offense: Camp instructor/counselor along with the Director, will discuss behavior with camper.
- Second offense: Camp instructor/counselor along with the Director, will discuss behavior with parent.
- Third offense: Camp instructor/counselor along with the Director, notifies parent in the evening that parent must pick up child before noon of the next day. No refund.

**NOTE:** The Virginia Space Flight Academy reserves the right to immediately dismiss a child from camp, with no previous notice to parent, if that child displays serious or disruptive behavior which endangers self, others or property.
