



What to bring to camp

We recommend that you use a permanent marker to write your name on everything you bring

Important:

- Bedding: each camper will get a twin size bed, but they must provide their own sheets, blankets and pillows.
- Closed-toe shoes: Sandals and opened-toe shoes are not allowed most places on the NASA base!
- Medication: please pack all medication in a ziplock bag with the instructions and dosage written out on a 3x5 card. All medication will be held by the staff.
- Towels (it's recommended to have one for the showers and one for the beach)
- Toiletries and a small carrying case
- Clothing for the week

Optional:

- Spending money: all activities are paid for in advance, but there are a few gift shops and opportunities to buy extra snacks. We recommend no more than \$50
- An extra pillowcase or laundry bag for dirty clothes
- A hat or cap
- Jacket/Raincoat
- Flashlight
- A disposable camera.
- Sunscreen and insect repellent

Cell Phones are NOT allowed at camp, parents will be able to reach their child for emergencies by calling the camp phone. The number will be provided at registration.

Please leave other electronic games and devices home as we cannot be responsible for them and several places we visit on base will not allow them. In the evening we will post a few photos of the day's activities for the parents to enjoy.
